

# B.S. Nursing - Accelerated

## Program Admission Requirements

Students interested in the Accelerated program must have completed a Bachelor's degree in an area other than nursing prior to application.

There are two sets of admission requirements: Set A must be completed before application to the program; Set B must be completed before beginning the program. **Every prospective student must meet with the Nursing advisor to be eligible to apply to the program.**
