

# B.S. Nursing - R.N. Completion

## Program Admission Requirements

### Before applying to the BSN Completion program:

- Students must either
  - 1) possess an associate degree in nursing, or
  - 2) be enrolled in an associate degree in nursing program.
- Students must have a minimum combined GPA of "C" (2.0) in their previous nursing-specific courses.
- Every prospective student must meet with the Nursing advisor to be eligible to apply to the program.**

The following courses may be taken either before students begin the BSN Completion program, or as co-requisite courses during the BSN Completion program.
